### School Book Rental Scheme

Our School Book Rental Scheme enables children to get a lot of their books on loan from the school. This keeps the cost of the schoolbooks at a more manageable level and is excellent value which you will see when you get the Booklists next week. Costs saved grow incrementally as your child goes up through the school. We balance the costs across the 8 years in school so it stays at a very reasonable charge throughout.
